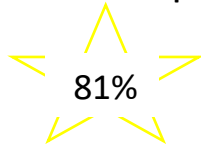

The raffle will be drawn on Wednesday 5th April so please make sure your tickets are returned before Wednesday morning.

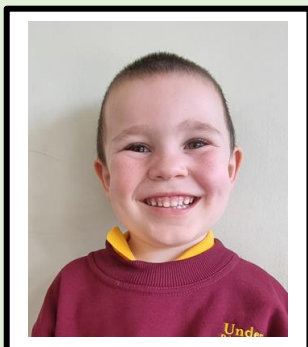
End of term
