### School Photos

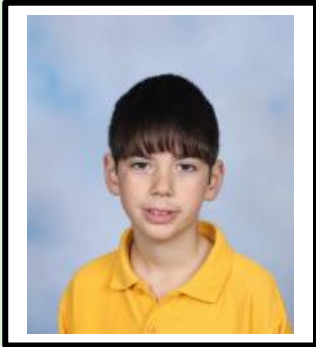
School Photos will be held on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> June. We have sent home envelopes and details as to how to order your school photos.
